



Scholarship Opportunities

The Kentucky Corn Growers Association is proud to announce the availability of three scholarships to high school seniors and current college students pursuing degrees in agriculture or a related field from an accredited college, university, or trade school for the 2012/2013 school year:

- Two \$1,000 scholarships for high school seniors
- One \$2,000 scholarship for an existing college student (undergrad or graduate)

Either the student or the student's parents/guardians must be a Kentucky Corn Grower Association member to qualify. Applicants will be judged on academic performance (minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale and minimum ACT score of 18 if required by the post secondary institution), citizenship, leadership, and the role they want to play in the future of agriculture.

Applications are available on the Kentucky Corn Growers' website at www.kycorn.org and are **due in the KyCGA office on February 1, 2012**. It is also required that the applicants submit the following information with their application form:

- (1) Two letters of recommendation,
- (2) Most recent transcript, and;
- (3) Completion of a comprehensive essay.

Scholarship winners will be announced April 1, 2012. Awards will be sent directly to the winners' accredited institution no later than August 1, 2012 and may be used for tuition, housing, books and other educational expenses. In the event that a student is not enrolled in coursework by the Fall 2012 semester, the award may be forfeited unless serious illness or injury prevents enrollment. In such case, the award may be used the following semester.
